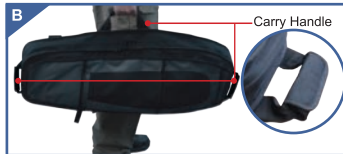
CARRY OPTIONS



A. After securing the firearm in the pack, carry it on one shoulder with the wider end up. Adjust the Shoulder Strap and the Support Strap to fit the pack to body.



- 1 Well-padded 2-section Shoulder Strap comes with heavy duty buckles, fully adjustable from 28" to 54", and switchable for either right shoulder or left shoulder carry.
- 2 Additional Support Strap connects to either side of the sling pack to provide further stability.
- 3 Strap Keeper and Elastic Loop help keep straps organized and stable.

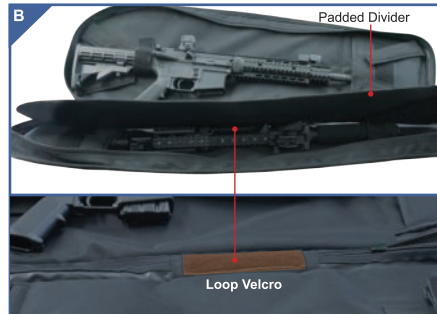


B. After securing the firearm(s) in the pack, you can hand carry horizontally with the side handle, or use the top or the bottom handle for a quick grab-and-go.

STORAGE OPTIONS



A. Open the compartment to place the firearm on one side of the pack. Insert the barrel into the padded Barrel Catch Pocket. Select an appropriate Loop position and use the provided Velcro Strap to loop and secure the stock of the firearm.



B. When storing 2 firearms, attach the Padded Divider to the Loop Velcro in the spine between 2 sides to separate and protect the 2 firearms.

SET UP FIREARM FOR QUICK PULL ACTIONS

Four Pull Tabs (shown in Image A in the Storage Options section) are provided for flexible set-up per user preferences. Two examples are shown below:



1. Remove the divider and place only one firearm in the pack.

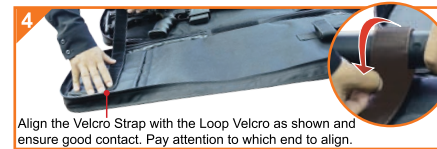


2. Insert the barrel into the Barrel Catch Pocket inside the back panel of the pack.



3. Detach the Velcro Strap from the loop.

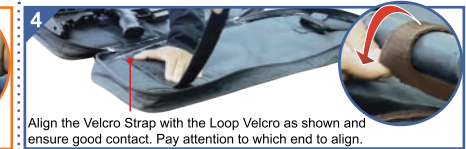
A. Right-hand Users



Align the Velcro Strap with the Loop Velcro as shown and ensure good contact. Pay attention to which end to align.

4A. Place the Hook Velcro of the detachable Velcro Strap onto the Loop Velcro sewn on the opposite Barrel Catch Pocket, leaving the extra length for later use. Position the butt stock over to the front panel. Loop and secure it with the remaining length of the Velcro Strap.

B. Left-hand Users



Align the Velcro Strap with the Loop Velcro as shown and ensure good contact. Pay attention to which end to align.

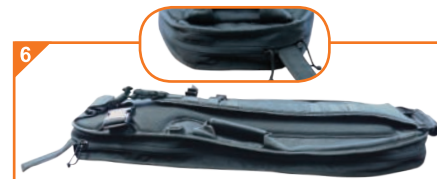
4B. Place the Hook Velcro of the detachable Velcro Strap onto the Loop Velcro sewn on the opposite Barrel Catch Pocket, leaving the extra length for later use. Position the butt stock over to the front panel. Loop and secure it with the remaining length of the Velcro Strap.



5A. After securing the firearm, unfold and extend the Pull Tab as shown in Figure 5A. Fold and tuck the remaining 3 Pull Tabs inside the pack.



5B. After securing the firearm, unfold and extend the Pull Tab as shown in Figure 5B. Fold and tuck the remaining 3 Pull Tabs inside the pack.



6A. Close and zip the pack, leaving the Pull Tab extended out as shown in Figure 6A. Make appropriate adjustment of the Shoulder Strap and the Support Strap for comfortable carry.



6B. Close and zip the pack, leaving the Pull Tab extended out as shown in Figure 6B. Make appropriate adjustment of the Shoulder Strap and the Support Strap for comfortable carry.

QUICK PULL ILLUSTRATIONS

RIGHT HAND APPLICATION - EXAMPLE 1



1. Left hand grabs the top Carry Handle above shoulder to pull forward, and right hand pushes the pack from the bottom if needed.



2. Left hand grabs the Pull Tab outward and down to open the sling pack.



3. Right hand pulls out the firearm.

LEFT HAND APPLICATION - EXAMPLE 1



1. Right hand grabs the top Carry Handle above shoulder to pull forward, and left hand pushes the pack from the bottom if needed.



2. Right hand grabs the Pull Tab outward and down to open the sling pack.



3. Left hand pulls out the firearm.

RIGHT HAND APPLICATION - EXAMPLE 2



1. Right hand pulls the bottom Carry Handle forward from behind the waist, and left hand pushes the pack to front if needed.



2. Left hand grabs the Pull Tab to open the sling pack.



3. Right hand pulls out the firearm.

LEFT HAND APPLICATION - EXAMPLE 2



1. Left hand pulls the bottom Carry Handle forward from behind the waist, and right hand pushes the pack to front if needed.



2. Right hand grabs the Pull Tab to open the sling pack.



3. Left hand pulls out the firearm.
